Subgroup Updates:

Protocol

An update on the status of the protocol review took place, with input from members of the Protocol Review group who were in attendance. It was agreed to include ability for borrowing to allow for a Credit Card to be obtained for bill payment. The Executive to further review and members reminded to forward any feedback they have.

Fundraising Group

The sub group proposed the idea of a restructuring workshop for forum members to be looked at engaging in, they had obtained a company who could do this for us. The cost of this would be approx 1750 euro's. It was agreed to look for a brief from the company and the Forum would review and get back to them by the end of June. Looking for Leader funding was mentioned in relation to the Christmas Lights.

Social Inclusion

A communication board for the playground expected to be erected in the next few weeks. Group working on funding for new playground equipment from WCC. Update on proposed Community centre, this is progressing with the contracts now with Solicitors. WCC looking at funding streams for the centre, in addition to monies received under T&VR.



Planning

Cairn Homes are proceeding with phase one of the town park, Liam had mentioned about a sensory garden for the park and has sent a list of proposed planting. First phase of park should be open by September/October. Paul mentioned it might be a good idea to ask Cairn homes for a story board to be completed on any artefacts that may be found during the building

Tidy Towns

Judging has now commenced for the Tidy Towns competition, the group have seen an increase in volunteers, particularly from Ukranian people and other nationalities which is very positive.
