It was noted that it might be a good idea to ask Cairn homes for a story board to be completed on any artefacts that may be found during the building, and maybe a storyboard on the history of the site.

The Town Centre First plan for Blessington is underway, with Blessington being designated a pathway town, this is an important activity, and there will be consultants appointed by WCC to conduct a review, this will involve Community outreach. The plan should ensure Blessington and WCC are in a position to react to the next tranche of RRDF funding stream.
